

Notarization and Authentication

Notarization is an official fraud-deterrent process that assures the parties of a transaction the document is authentic and can be trusted.

Notarization is an assurance by the Notary Public that the document is authentic, or a signature is genuine and that the signor acted without duress or intimidation and intended the terms of the document to be in full force and effect.

You may require notarization of any of the following documents:

- ✔ Insurance loss declarations
- ✔ Certified true copies of documents
- ✔ Execution or authentication of international documents
- ✔ Letters of invitation
- ✔ Authorization for minor travel
- ✔ Proof of identity for travel purposes
- ✔ Passport application documentation



Authenticating Documents To Legalize Use Of The Document Outside Of Canada

Foreign government and organizations require documents to be authenticated in order to be accepted for use in their jurisdiction.

The process of authentication can sometimes be overwhelming and involve many parties. We at Sekhon Notary take care of the process from start to finish.
